

# Download Moondance Flute Solo Music

Moondance is the third studio album by Northern Irish singer-songwriter Van Morrison. It was released on 27 February 1970 by Warner Bros. Records. After the commercial failure of his first Warner Bros. album *Astral Weeks* (1968), Morrison moved to upstate New York with his wife and began writing songs for *Moondance*. There, he met the musicians that would record the album with him at New York City ... "Moondance" is a song recorded by Northern Irish singer and songwriter Van Morrison and is the title song on his third studio album *Moondance* (1970). The yang to *Astral Weeks*' yin, the brilliant *Moondance* is every bit as much a classic as its predecessor; Van Morrison's first commercially successful solo effort, it retains the previous album's deeply spiritual thrust but transcends its bleak, cathartic intensity to instead explore themes of renewal and redemption. Light, soulful, and jazzy, *Moondance* opens with the sweetly nostalgic "And It ... Our brand new CD, "Bring It & Swing It" has just come out! This is our 12th CD! You can collect 'em all, starting with our 1979 debut, recorded live at Toad's Place in New Haven.
